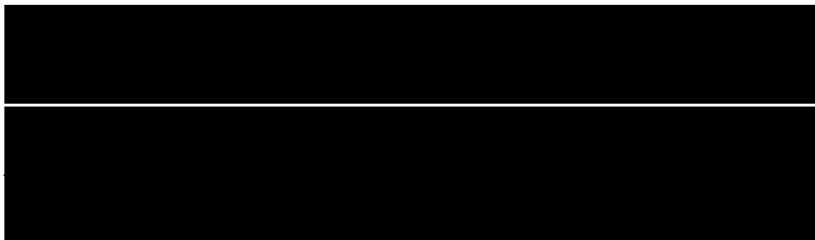

Details: AO/ Ofc. Warden and I were dispatched to the listed location regarding a possible trespasser. Dispatch advised the trespasser was still in the building.

The listed location is a multi-unit, multi-building apartment complex located on the south side of W. 11th Ave. The apartment complex is newly constructed and has very few occupied units. The involved building is located on the northwest portion of the complex. The unit is two-story, with the front door facing the interior courtyard of the complex.

I contacted C/Stone and C/Breen in front of the listed location. Breen told me the following: Breen is a Principal Broker for V/Jennings and Co. The apartment complex has had a significant problem with "vagrancy" issues due to the fact it is not fully occupied.

According to Breen, on 091709 the listed unit was "broken into". An employee with Jennings and Co. discovered a subject inside and "ran them out." Breen knew of "at least one other time" the unit was broken into. Breen believed the subjects are accessing the apartment by climbing onto the low front porch roof and then prying open a second story window.


Stone advised the window screen on the second story window appeared to be bent. Breen stated there appeared to be no other damage to the unit.

Stone was at the location to become familiar with the property since she is potentially going to manage the complex. Stone stated she inspected the first floor of the unit and noted it to be clean other than some trash (water bottle). Initially, she believed the "cleaning crew" had left the bottle. When she climbed the stairs to the second floor, to inspect the upstairs bedrooms and bathroom, she observed a subject sleeping on the floor of one of the bedrooms. She noted there were small items strewn about the floor, including a pair of scissors. She stated the subject was located in the "far right" (southwest) bedroom.


Stone did not see anyone else and quickly "backed out" of the apartment and exited the front door. The subject was not confronted.

Stone was surprised the subject did not move and believe them to be "passed out." Stone described the subjects as an A/M, dark hair, early 20's without a shirt.

Breen and Stone both confirmed the listed unit was not rented and no one was permitted to be inside. Breen advised he wanted the "person arrested" for trespassing.

Based on Breen and Stone's statements, the history of "break ins" and the on-going issues with this specific apartment unit, I believe there was a crime.

Breen provided a key for apartment. Stone left the location, while Breen remained out front of the complex.

Ofc. Warden and I approached the front door of the apartment and it appeared there were no lights on inside the apartment. I turned the front door knob and discovered the door was unlocked. I opened the front door and announced "Eugene Police." I also advised anyone inside the apartment to come to the front door with their hands in the air. I did not hear any response. Ofc. Warden and I remained at the door for a few seconds waiting. After believing there was no one coming to the door, we entered and checked the first floor. I noted there were no indications of a renter (furniture, groceries, mail, etc.).


As we began to climb the stairs to second floor, Ofc. Warden stopped mid-way due to the fact we heard a rustling noises from one of the bedrooms. Ofc. Warden announced our presence and for any occupants to make themselves known. At this time, [REDACTED] appeared from one of the bedrooms. (I was behind Ofc. Warden and was unable to see which bedroom.)

[REDACTED] was directed to descend the stairs, towards us, and to keep his hands raised. It appeared [REDACTED] did not clearly understand our directions since he was slow to comply. Eventually, [REDACTED] descended and was placed in hand cuffs without incident. I attempted to ascertain from [REDACTED] if there were any other occupants inside. [REDACTED] was unable to provide a sufficient answer.


As no one else had appeared, Ofc. Warden advised he would check the remaining upstairs areas. I remained with [REDACTED] on the stairs. I heard Ofc. Warden walking around, however, I could not clearly see him from my location.

After a few moments, I heard Ofc. Warden yelling "show me your hands." I heard Ofc. Warden say this several times. I did not hear any other voices. I then heard Ofc. Warden advised he would deploy his Taser if the subject(s) did not comply.

At this point, I heard what I believed to be a physical altercation between Ofc. Warden and a subject(s). I heard a loud thump, like objects striking the floor of the bedroom.

I did not know who, or how many subjects, Ofc. Warden was confronting and was concerned for his safety. I took [REDACTED] by the arm and he and I quickly ascended the few remaining steps to Ofc. Warden's location.

As I stepped into the doorway of bedroom containing Ofc. Warden, I observed one subject, later identified as [REDACTED] sitting upright on a blanket, his lower torso was covered with another blanket. Ofc. Warden was near his feet and was attempting to stand up, as if he had just been on the floor. As Ofc. Warden stood up, he deployed his Taser, striking [REDACTED] in the upper right chest area. ([REDACTED] did not have a shirt on.)

[REDACTED] rolled onto his stomach and was placed into handcuffs without further incident. See Ofc. Warden's report for additional details.

At this time, I attempted to communicate with both [REDACTED] regarding why we were at the location. It became clear neither spoke English well enough to understand my statements. [REDACTED] was also attempting to communicate to me. After a brief interaction of broken English, [REDACTED] indicated for me to look at documents that were on the floor near [REDACTED] blanket. I looked though the documents and discovered what looked to be a rental agreement.


I took the documents to Breen who looked at them and confirmed, much to his surprise, the apartment had been rented to [REDACTED]

After further research and contacting employees, Breen discovered [REDACTED] had originally been listed to rent another unit in the complex, but then it was changed "at the last moment" (today). The updated information had not been passed onto Breen.


Breen was extremely apologetic for the error.

I contacted the "Language Line" in order to assist with explaining the situation to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. After explaining the error, [REDACTED] were left at the location. I provided them with a business card, incident number and Breen's business card.

All/ Breen left the location prior to me returning the key to him. I contacted Breen via cell and advised him the key would be at the front counter of City Hall. I left the key the front counter.

C/ Breen, Timothy J. W/M 6/28/65

DETAILS: I was dispatched to [REDACTED] regarding trespassers. Upon arrival I contacted Barnes and Breen. Breen advised they have been having ongoing problems with trespassers at the location. I heard him tell Barnes no one was allowed in the location. Breen told us the power to the location was on and he had been inside the apartment. He said he went inside and found a person passed out upstairs. He said he only observed one person inside the apartment.

Barnes and I went to the front door. I noticed the front door had a key box on it. We opened the door and announced our presence. All the lights were of and no one responded to our calls inside. Barnes and I cleared the first floor and were climbing the stairs when [REDACTED] started to come down the stairs. He would not obey my commands to put his hands on his head. He continued to walk towards us. Barnes and I were able to take [REDACTED] into custody.

I continued upstairs and found [REDACTED] inside a bedroom. He was lying on the floor and would not show me his hands when ordered to. He was covered in a blanket. I continued to yell at him to show me his hands and got negative results. I drew my Taser and again ordered [REDACTED] to show me his hands. [REDACTED] just stared at me and did not saying anything to me. [REDACTED] sat up but still had his right hand hidden under the blanket. I continued to tell him to show me his hand. I attempted to push [REDACTED] over with my foot. He just leaned against the wall while now sitting and still had his hand hidden under the blanket.

I attempted to pull the blanket off of [REDACTED] When I did I got knocked to the ground onto my right side. I was now tangled in the blanket and [REDACTED] legs. While I was on the ground [REDACTED] turned towards me. I thought [REDACTED] was coming at me to potentially hurt me and told him to get back. He continued towards me ignoring my commands to now get back. I stood quickly and deployed my Taser striking [REDACTED] on the right side of his

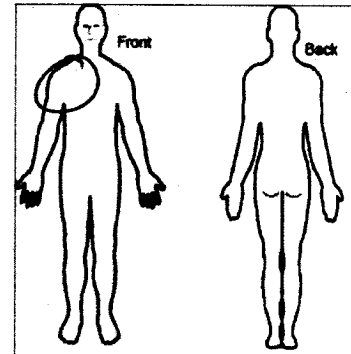
