Giltinan stated he was standing in front of the Magic Gardens bar when he saw Bechard (X1) shove Lowe (SB). Giltinan stated Lowe then tried to restrain Bechard by grabbing his arms. Giltinan then stated Bechard took a step back from Lowe and then punched Lowe in the face. Giltinan was unable to state which hand Bechard punched Lowe with. Giltinan stated Lowe then punched back at Bechard and a lot of punches were being exchanged by both Bechard and Lowe. Giltinan stated both Bechard and Lowe were active in the fight and at some point the fight went to the ground. Additionally, Giltinan stated words were exchanged between Bechard and Lowe prior to the fight, but did not know what was said.</p>

There were several people standing around and Officer Fender asked me to get witness' statements.														
8 Officer Fender and Officer Abrahamson requested fire/medical for removal of taser probes from (SB) Brady and water for (X1) Bechard who was pepper sprayed.														
8 I talked with (W1) Freylack and she said (X1) Bechard had head butted and punched (SB) Lowe "for know reason." (W1) Freylack went on to say that (X1) Bechard had been kicked out of their culinary show earlier at the Davis Street Pub. Freylack told me Bechard had been upset about out of state judges and

participants in the show. Freylack said that Bechard was very angry that a pig was brought in from Iowa and not from Oregon. Freylack said she saw Bechard get into (SB) Lowe's face and head butted him and started to throw punches at Lowe. Freylack said (X1) Bechard was consistently starting trouble.

8 I talked to (X1) Bechard who was sitting on the sidewalk just south of the Magic Garden. Bechard told me he was "attacked." Bechard states he thinks it is "messed up" that the culinary show would have guests from " San Francisco and that a pig was brought all the way in from Iowa." Bechard told me "people need to support Oregon farmers and local business." Bechard stated that he is just trying to "educate people" on supporting local farmers. I asked Bechard what happened on the sidewalk earlier and he said (SB) Brady started throwing elbows towards his face and before he knew it he was on the ground.

8 I talked with (SB) Ingle and he told me that (SB) Brady "was all fired up." Ingle said that Brady was "talking shit about Portland." I asked Ingle if he saw a fight and he said he saw his buddy (X1) Bechard fighting. I asked Ingle how long he knew Bechard and he said "I just met him tonight." Ingle was not able to give me any details regarding the actual fight.

8 I talked with Officer Fender and Officer Abrahamson regarding statements made to them. I determined that (X1) Bechard was the aggressor. Officer Risley and I cuffed and checked for tightness, double locked Bechard. I inventoried Bechard and he had nothing of value on his person. I transported Bechard to MCDC and enroute Officer Abrahamson stated to Bechard his Miranda Rights and Bechard responded he understood his rights at 0304 hours.

8 (X1) Bechard was charged with Disorderly Conduct II, Harassment, and Interfering with a Peace Officer. (SB) Lowe was transported by Officer Fender to MCDC and charged with Disorderly Conduct II and Interfering with a Peace Officer. Refer to Officer Fender's Special and Custody Report.

Ms. Uriba said the competition is touring the United States and has come to Portland this weekend. Uriba said the competition selects five different wine makers and five chefs to compete in the competition.</p>

8 Ms. Uriba told me she was concerned for Lowe's welfare since his head had been cut and he had been kicked in the head and wanted to know if he needed an ambulance. Ms. Uriba asked me if she could speak with Lowe prior to us transporting him in order to reassure her Lowe was alright. After obtaining permission from Officer Fender, I opened the back of the patrol vehicle for Ms. Uriba to speak with Lowe. Ms. Uriba immediately asked Lowe if he was alright and needed an ambulance. Lowe, who's head was not bleeding, stated his only concern was that he not been able to see for at least twenty minutes and was angry no one had helped him, otherwise he was fine. Lowe clarified he had lost his vision for twenty minutes not because of being hit/kicked but because of being pepper sprayed. Lowe stated he could now see and was fine.

I explained to Berchard his unruly behavior tonight had caused great alarm by onlookers and even in a mutual combat fight, both parties can be taken to jail.
