13           B.     \$525,001.00 shall be deposited by Defendant State of Washington, DSHS into the  
 14 Registry of the King County Superior Court no later than three business days after the date of  
 15 entry and filing of this judgment;

16           C.     Upon presentation of identification, the King County Superior Court Clerk is  
 17 directed to release the funds to plaintiffs' counsel, David P. Moody of Hagens Berman Sobol  
 18 Shapiro, LLP;

19           D.     Release of funds to plaintiffs' counsel does not constitute constructive receipt by  
 20 Monica, a disabled minor. Monica's portion of the settlement may be wired from Hagens  
 21 Berman Sobol Shapiro LLP directly to Michael Longyear, Esq., the court-appointed litigation  
 22 guardian and settlement guardian for Monica pending further instructions from the Court in the


23 guardianship matter. *As SGAL, Mr Longyear will recommend approval of*  
 24 *this settlement and judgment amount on behalf of Monica.*

25           E.     Upon receipt of \$525,001.00, the Court Clerk shall enter satisfaction of the  
 26 judgment against Defendant State of Washington, DSHS; and





1 F. The Court Clerk shall take all necessary steps to close this matter, including the  
2 removal of all prior case scheduling orders.


