The station also maintains an Internship program. Interns are selected by the staff of News and Production Departments to give those students the experience of working in a broadcast environment. Students receive academic credit for the time spent with the station. The internships are usually done on an academic quarter and are done year round.

All upper level job openings are posted with the a trade magazine that pertains to that field. Some of those posting have been with Spots and Dots, a sales related trade magazine and Society of Broadcast Engineers trade magazine. These publications reach all memberships including women and minorities.
