- Count 01: ORS 260.715 False Statement Under the Election Laws (C Felony)
- Count 02: ORS 260.715 False Statement Under the Election Laws (C Felony)

committed as follows:

COUNT 01 The defendant, on or about May 20, 2008, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly make a false statement when a statement was required under the election laws of the State of Oregon, by signing the "Voter's Statement" on the ballot return envelope for the ballot issued to Shaman David Keaton, said act in violation of state statutes in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oregon.

COUNT 02 The defendant, on or about November 4, 2008, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly make a false statement when a statement was required under the election laws of the State of Oregon, by signing the "Voter's Statement" on the ballot return envelope for the ballot issued to Shaman David Keaton, said act in violation of state statutes in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oregon.


