INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about August 4, 2009, in Greene County, in the Western District of Missouri, MATTHEW O'DELL, defendant herein, did knowingly possess one or more matters, which contained any visual depiction that had been mailed, shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, and which was produced using materials which had been mailed, shipped, or transported in interstate and foreign commerce, by any means including by computer, the production of which involved the use of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct and which visual depiction was of such conduct, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).
