COME NOW Howard Weinberg, Ph.D., Licensee, and the State of Iowa and enter into the following Stipulated Order:

1. On April 16, 2008, the Licensee was charged with possession of images depicting the exploitation of a minor in Johnson County District Court. On April 17, 2008, the Licensee was released to the supervision of the Department of Correctional Services and was ordered to have no contact with minors.

2. The Licensee has maintained a practice as a family psychologist in Iowa City, Iowa for several years.

3. Licensee and the State submit this Stipulated Order for Board approval.

4. In order to meet the Board's interest in protecting the public while the criminal charge against the Licensee is pending, the parties agree to the following:

a. Further investigation by the Board into this matter will be continued until the criminal charge against the Licensee is resolved.

b. Licensee will not practice any aspect of psychology until the criminal charge against him is resolved and further order is entered by the Board.

c. This Stipulated Order is a public record.

5. In the event the Licensee practices psychology in violation of this Stipulated Order, the Board may initiate appropriate action to revoke or suspend Licensee's license or to impose other discipline as authorized in Iowa Code Section 272C.3(2)(a) (2007).

6. This Stipulated Order is voluntarily submitted by Licensee and the State to the

Board for its consideration. Respondent does not admit that grounds exist for an emergency adjudicative proceeding, but he does agree to entry of this order as his voluntary act and deed, in full waiver of his right to a contested case hearing under Iowa Code section 17A.18A.5.

Respondent does not waive his right to seek reinstatement of his license to active status in the future and may file an application for reinstatement in the future.

7. This Stipulated Order must be approved by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Stipulated Order it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

This stipulated order is approved by the board on April 30, 2008.
