JEFFERSON SUMMER SCHOOL TO BEGIN TUESDAY, JUNE 24, 2008

Jefferson, WI: June 19, 2008 Superintendent of Schools Michael Swartz has announced that the 2008 Summer School session will begin on Tuesday, June 24. This opening will be contingent upon no change in current water levels. Staff and students will be instructed to stay away from all groundwater on the High School site. This area of the school grounds will be fenced off.

In an effort to conserve water, portable toilets will be on site at the High School and West Elementary for staff and student use. In addition, hand sanitizers will be provided.

The first session of swimming has been canceled. The pool will remain closed until further notice. Students scheduled for swim lessons during first session will be rescheduled into other classes.

Summer School transportation options for families have been adjusted and are as follows:

- Due to recent road closures, a new south/north shuttle will be available. Jefferson Bus Service (JBS), 1501 S. Industrial Avenue, Jefferson, will be the pick-up and drop-off point for the new south/north shuttle. Students attending summer school will be allowed to leave their bikes at JBS while they are at summer school. The shuttle departure time will be 7:15 a.m. and the return time will be 12:45 p.m.
- A shuttle will also run from East Elementary School, 120 S. Sanborn Avenue, Jefferson. Buses will depart at 7:40 a.m. and will return at 12:15 p.m.
- The Sullivan shuttle times will remain the same with a 7:20 a.m. departure time and a return time of 1:00 p.m.
