



**Seven Cedars Casino "Seven in the 7th" Contest
Official Contest Rules**

Contest Entry Dates: Monday, March 17th, 2008 – Monday, September 22nd, 2008

CONTEST VALID: Monday, March 17th, 2008 to Monday, September 28th, 2008. KOMO 1000 News and Seven Cedars reserve the right to change this schedule at any time.

DRAWING OF CONTESTANTS: Contestant Names will be read on air in the Mariner Radio Broadcast during the seventh inning. There are 162 contestants total throughout the 2008 Seattle Mariners regular season (one per game).

PRIZE WINNER WILL RECEIVE:

- Prize winner will receive \$7,000 cash!
- Value of the prize pack is \$7,000
- Odds of winning are determined by the said event happening

TO ENTER/QUALIFY: Seven Cedars Casino "Seven in the 7th" contest is an enter-to-win contest in which participants can enter at participating Seven Cedars Casino locations or online at <http://www.komonews.com/marinersradio/contests>

- To enter the contest via mail, participants can pick up an official entry blank at Seven Cedars Casino locations, fill it out completely, and mail it to KOMO 1000 News at the address specified on the entry card. Or, any listener unable to pick up an entry blank may send in a 3 x 5 card with the name of the contest, entrant's name, address, daytime and evening phone numbers, email address and date of birth to Seven Cedars Casino "Seven in the 7th", c/o KOMO 1000 News, 140 4th Avenue North Suite #340, Seattle, WA 98109. All entries must be received no later than Monday, September 22nd, 2008 at 5:00pm Pacific Standard Time.

The entrant must click on the "Click here" to enter and complete the requested information to enter the contest. All entries must be received no later than Monday, September 22nd, 2008 at 5:00pm Pacific Standard Time.

HOW IT WORKS: KOMO 1000 News will randomly select and announce the name of a contestant during the seventh inning of the game who is qualified for a chance to win \$7,000 in cash. If the Mariners get 7 runs in the 7th inning the contestant wins \$7,000 in cash. A Designated Game is a regulation Seattle Mariners Game (home or away) and must be counted as such by an Official League game. To qualify for seven runs in the 7th inning all seven runs must be scored as such by an official scorer. Contestant Names will be read on air in the Mariner Radio Broadcast. There are 162 contestants total throughout the 2008 Seattle Mariners regular season (one per game). Maximum two (2) Grand Prize winners during the 2008 Seattle Mariners regular season.
