

WSBT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

WSBT offers internships for college level students majoring in broadcasting, communications, or a related field. The station strives to give the student in-depth practical experience in areas of interest, as well as an overview of the station in general. WSBT internships also give the student the opportunity to interact with professionals in all areas of the television and radio industry.

WSBT requires that the student be a junior or senior with an overall grade point average of "B". All interns must attend an accredited college or university and must provide a letter from their school verifying the student is actively enrolled and will receive academic credit for the internship. The station also requires a completed internship application from the student, two letters of recommendation, and a personal interview with the student. The majority of WSBT's internships are unpaid and in exchange for college credit only. Employment with the station is not permitted during or in conjunction with an internship.

Internships are available spring, summer and fall semesters.

Spring Internships - January through May with an application deadline of December 15.

Summer Internships - May through August with an application deadline of April 15.

Fall Internships - September through December with an application deadline of August 15.
