

# Detour Route: Olympia to Aberdeen

## To Aberdeen from Olympia:

Travel on SR 101 north to SR 108 at the Kamilche interchange, west on SR 108 to SR 8 at McCleary then west on SR 8 to US 12 at Elma, west on US 12 to SR 107 at Montesano then south on SR 107 to US 101 at Artic then north on US 101 to Aberdeen.

## From Aberdeen to Olympia:

Travel south on US 101 to the junction of SR 107. Take SR 107 to Montesano and follow to State Route 8 eastbound. Follow State Route 8 to McCleary and head east on SR 108 to Kamilche (Little Creek Casino) and take US 101 south. Exit US 101 at Steamboat Island Road and take a right on Madrona Beach road. Follow back to US 101 at Mud bay and follow south to Olympia.

# Detour Route: Portland to Seattle

## From Portland area:

From the Portland area: East on Oregon's I-84 then north on I-82 to The Tri-Cities and Ellensburg and then west on I-90 to Seattle.

## From Seattle area:

East on I-90 to Yakima and then south on I-82 at Ellensburg to The Tri-Cities then west on Oregon's I-84 to Portland.

**NOTE:** State Route 7 reserved for local traffic only. Commercial vehicles over 10,000 lbs. GVW are not allowed on State Route 7, from US 12 between Tacoma and Morton. WSDOT, WSP and the National Guard are assisting with traffic control on SR 7 and other areas. US 12, US 97 are open as secondary routes, however, these are two-lane mountain pass highways. Only those familiar with these roads are encouraged to take these routes as weather conditions are still changing at this time.
