



I-264 BERKLEY BRIDGE GRID DECK REPLACEMENT

April –June 2010



The Berkley Bridge Grid Deck Replacement project will replace four concrete filled sections of the I-264 bridge over a six-week period beginning at the end of April. Each of the four bridge deck section replacements require a weekend bridge closure to allow crews access to the work site and for the concrete to set after the work is complete. Closures will begin on Friday night at 8 p.m. and will be removed by Monday morning at 5 a.m. The Midtown Tunnel is the suggested alternate route during the closures.

I-264 WEST CLOSURE:

Friday, April 23 to Monday, April 26

Friday, April 30 to Monday, May 3

WESTBOUND DETOUR:

The planned I-264 West closure will require traffic to exit I-264 at Campostella Road (Exit 11A) to enter the I-264 West detour using the Campostella Bridge (Route 460). The detour will take traffic over the Campostella Bridge to Wilson Road/Indian River Road/Berkley Avenue where I-264 and I-464 can be accessed. Downtown bound traffic will continue on I-264 West past Exit 11A and must exit at City Hall Avenue (Exit 9) or Waterside Drive (Exit 10).

Alternate dates in case of weather delays:

Friday, May 7 to Monday, May 10

Friday, June 18 to Monday, June 21

I-264 EAST CLOSURE:

Friday, May 14 to Monday, May 17

Friday, June 4 to Monday, June 7

EASTBOUND DETOUR:

The planned I-264 East closure will require all traffic to merge into the right lane prior to the Downtown Tunnel in order to detour onto the Berkley Avenue / I-464 Exit. A lane closure will extend through the tunnel and onto the Berkley Avenue / I-464 Exit. Traffic on I-464 North will merge into the right lane prior to the junction with I-264 East. All traffic will exit at the East Berkley Avenue ramp and enter the I-264 East detour using the Campostella Bridge (Rte 460). The detour will take traffic to Berkley Avenue/Indian River Road/Campostella Bridge where I-264 East can be accessed. Downtown bound traffic will also be required to use this route.
