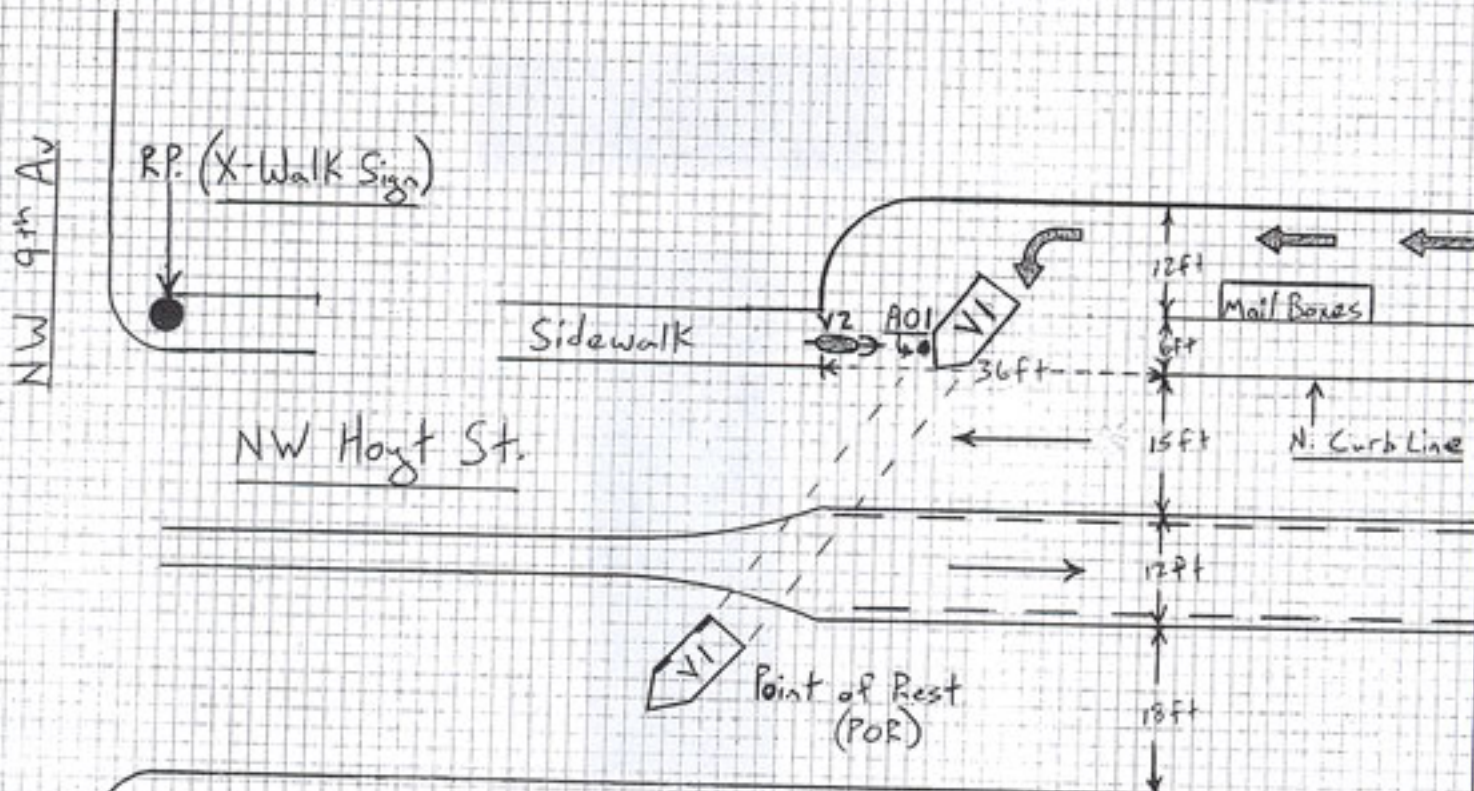

8 Officer Davidson and I were working a two person traffic car, and received a R/C of a trauma injury at the location. I was driving and officer Davidson was riding in the passenger seat. While we were enroute we received updated information that a radio cab had hit a bicyclist who was pinned under the cab. We arrived onscene at 1957 and began processing the scene. Officer Davidson took the necessary measurements while I conducted interviews. For crash diagram see Officer Davidson's attached report.

As I walked toward the crash scene medical personnel was attending to JAURON, who had been struck by the radio cab. I spoke with Officer Simon who told me that he had the driver of the radio cab in the back of his patrol car. I then interviewed GIDEON.

I asked GIDEON if he was okay and he said yes. I asked GIDEON if he was the driver of the radio cab that struck the bicyclist and he said yes. GIDEON then told me his name, address, and telephone number in response to my request for that information.

GIDEON told me that he was originally traveling eastbound on NW Hoyt but needed to go [REDACTED]

West in order to pick up a fare. GIDEON said that he then turned into the post office parking lot in order to turn around and head west on NW Hoyt. GIDEON said that he stopped prior to entering the roadway and that both east and west were clear. GIDEON told me that he then began inching out and heard a collision on the front passenger side of his vehicle. GIDEON said that he tried to stop on the brake pedal but his foot slipped, and hit the gas pedal for a second before coming to a stop.

GIDEON told me that he put the car into park and exited the vehicle. GIDEON also told me that he tried to call 9-1-1.

I inspected the radio cab which had several small spots of white paint transfer on the front right bumper. It should also be noted that GIDEON said JAURON was trapped underneath the car. I also noticed a small pool of blood on the ground underneath the radio cab, near the front driverside tire.

We left the crash scene at 2107 and went to Emanuel hospital. Once we arrived I spoke with the nurse who was tending to JAURON who told me that JAURON had several broken ribs, a collapsed lung, and abrasions on his face and body.

I spoke with JAURON who had difficulty

speaking due to chest pain. JAVRON told me that he saw the radio cab which was stopped. JAVRON said that he figured GIDEON saw him. JAVRON told me that he then remembered being hit by the bumper, then being on the hood for a second, and then being dragged under the car.

I collected JAVRON's belongs which had been left at the scene and left them with hospital staff. JAVRON's bicycle was taken to Central precinct property room by officer Simon.
