The City of Milwaukee Health Department will be distributing 700 free flood clean-up kits today Thursday, June 26 at Keenan Health Center located at 3200 N. 36th Street, Southside Health Center 1639 S. 23rd Street and Northwest Health Center located at 7630 W. Mill Road. The kits were awarded to the city by the American Red Cross in Southeastern Wisconsin and the Salvation Army of Greater Milwaukee for Milwaukee residents as they continue the cleaning and sterilization of their homes and businesses. The kits will be available for pick-up today on a first-come first-served basis while supplies last. The clean-up kits consist of a mop, broom, bucket, bleach, rubber gloves, garbage bags and sponges.
