COUNT I


The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Barry, State of Missouri, on information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.020, RSMo, committed the class A felony of Murder in the First Degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 565.020, RSMo, in that on or about November 2 through November 3, 2007 in the County of Barry, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused the death of R.F., by strangling her, after deliberation upon the matter.

COUNT II

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Barry, State of Missouri, on information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.030, RSMo, committed the unclassified felony of Forcible Rape, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.030, RSMo, in that on or about November 2 through November 3, 2007 in the County of Barry, State of Missouri, the defendant had sexual intercourse with R.F., by the use of forcible compulsion.

COUNT III

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Barry, State of Missouri, on information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.032 committed the unclassified felony of Statutory Rape in the First Degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.032, RSMo, in that on or about November 2 through November 3, 2007 in the County of Barry, State of Missouri, the defendant had sexual intercourse with R.F., who was less than fourteen years old.
